Sandeepe here is the 'spec' .

This is a NEAR proc that you call, so inside your code segment you do:

```
Extern      IsMsDos:near
```

This routine takes no arguments, it modifies flags and ONE BIT of the AX register:

```
call       IsMsDos
test      ax,2000h
jnz       This_Is_MSDOS
```

NOTES:

Do not try and trace into this routine, you will die.

Try to obscure as much as possible:

The code that makes this call and the code which prints the message based on the result are 'well separated'.

The bit that is set, and the bit that is looked at by the message guy are different bits.

The bit that controls the message is stored in a variable that is touched, read written, ALL OVER THE PLACE.
