I'm awaiting documentation from Booklink on the OLE custom interface they have implemented for us. I should have this by the end of the week. I'll set up a time with you in early December to review. Ideally, for Internet Assistant '95, I will simply unplug Booklink and plug in a revised Mosaic from you guys.

Word '95 is scheduled to ship at Win '95 + 30 days. Internet Assistant '95 will sim-ship with Word '95.

As food for thought, here's a quick summary of the services IW provides for us under our current interface:

- \* Gets URLs as files or streams
- \* Posts URLs (for forms, sensitive maps and isindex)
- \* Provides in-place objects for ftp and gopher
- \* Caches text and graphics
- \* Asynchronous download of text and graphics
- \* Provides download status information
- \* Manages external viewers for mime types Word can't handle.
