2. Flash Media Standards

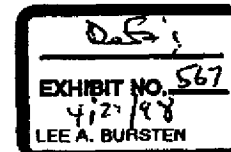
Thank you for you memo last week. I am glad that you are still working closely with Intel on this. Can you ensure that Greg sends the NDA here for my signature?

I think that it is very important that we listen to what Intel have to suggest regarding the progress of development of a Flash file system. I would like us to be very much involved in that effort and at least participate in whatever way makes most sense in the definition of an industry standard. Your suggestion for Intel to organise all interested parties into some kind of standards body is a good one. Please follow up with Don Verner to see what progress he has been able to make.

An important element in our strategy for DR DOS in FY91 is to be seen as a leading player in the proposal and development of new DOS standards. A Flash file system is a good example of the sort of activity we should be involved in for this purpose.
