**Subject:** NetShow 3.0 public beta release-- T-minus 12 days

The public release of the NetShow 3.0 beta will be announced on Monday May 4th. JimAll is the Networld + Interop keynote speaker on Wednesday May 6th, and his speech will be webcast live by Activate, a NetShow Service Provider in NetShow 3.0 format only. Below is information about the launch activities planned, plus links to drafts of documents currently in progress to support the public beta launch.

Note that many of the documents referenced below are still in draft format. Final versions will be ready on May 4th, most available on the NetShow website.

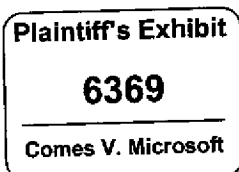

- Microsoft NetShow -- Tagline: The Windows NT Server streaming multimedia service
  - Part of Windows NT Server
  - Full streaming multimedia functionality, unicast and multicast support for bandwidths up to 500 Kbps
  - Includes server and tools; content played with new Microsoft Media Player
- Microsoft NetShow Theater Server (formerly code named Tiger) --Tagline: The broadcast-quality video server for Windows NT Server.
  - Standalone SKU
  - Broadcast quality streaming up to 8 Mbps
  - Includes server and tools; content played with new Microsoft Media Player
- Microsoft Media Player
  - Part of Windows
  - Universal media player that plays most local and streamed multimedia data types including ASF, AVI, WAV, RA/RV, Quicktime, and MPEG
  - Cross-platform (Mac and UNIX) players to play ASF content will be developed for RTM

**Pricing**

- NetShow: Included as a feature of Windows NT Server. No CALs required with NTS 4.0 (same as IIS).
- NetShow Theater Server: Pricing TBD. Will be announced at RTM
- Microsoft Media Player: Included as a feature of Windows.

- Microsoft NetShow Theater Server -- SKU thru Msft channels (expect very low volume)
