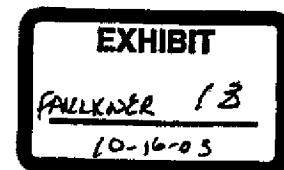
1. WMP 7 will have no impact on the U2 event.
