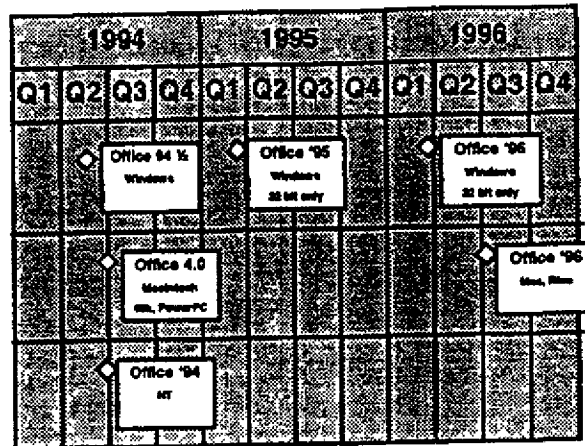

- ◆ Release on floppy and CD

Workgroup Release Plan

- ◆ Tactical '94 release
 - > Match Notes F/X in Word, Excel, PowerPoint = Office
 - > 10% better if totally easy
- ◆ Office '95
 - > Collaboration at the whole-document level
 - > Key scenario: semi-structured processes whose deliverables appear in the form of documents
 - > Key activities: finding/sharing information, doc library, routing, review/annotation
 - > Focus on MAPI stores, accessed through DNA subset
 - > Make MOM 2/Lauscher smart about processes and projects. Provide all workgroup UI centrally.
- ◆ Office '96
 - > Leverage unified shell to support above activities better, as well as more structured and more customized activities
 - > Collaboration at a sub-document level
 - > Category-specific workgroup features

Office '95 Theme

- ◆ Exploit Chicago, InfoCenter and Ren, to support users in workgroups performing the entire document life cycle.
- ◆ Ship March 1995
- ◆ 25% of development resources
 - > In parallel with Office '96
 - > Opportunistic shared code, e.g. workgroup features on MOM 2
- ◆ Chicago-only, 32 bit only
- ◆ We will NOT do:
 - > 16 bit, Mac, RISC, any hard NT-specific work
- ◆ Issue: How to support Win 3.1? See next slide.

Office '95 Win 3.1 Support

- ◆ Scenario 1: Keep 4.X coexisting with Office 95 as long as necessary (recommended scenario)
 - > Pros: Development/testing efficiency = maximum features
 - > Cons: Twice as many SKUs; Upgrade obligation (vouchers, etc.); Confusion
- ◆ Scenario 2: Do Win 32s Office
 - > Pros: One SKU; Sequence of upgrade does not matter; Supports MS strategic OS interests
 - > Cons: Performance; Development/testing cost; Adds about 1 disk per box
- ◆ Scenario 3: Do 16 bit Office
 - > Pros: Best Win 3.1 performance
 - > Cons: Some development/testing cost; Either multi SKU or high COGS; Does not encourage Chicago upgrade
- ◆ We are currently collecting feedback from our top 20 corporate accounts

Office '95 Key Features

- ◆ **Exploit Chicago**
 - > Long file names, e.g. file dialogs, title bars, auto propose name
 - > UNC & link dereferencing, e.g. file dialogs, command line
 - > Registry, e.g. small icons, class ID, Print To, INI settings
 - > Chicago visuals, e.g. window appearance, tabs, system metrics
 - > Chicago MRU
 - > Use comdlg (or comdlg-like) dialogs, e.g. Open, Save As
 - > Shell accessible properties, e.g. author, creation date, annotated
 - > Plug and play, e.g. change in accessibility of a file, resolution change, low power
 - > Chicago tray provides task switching. (MOM does not.)
 - > Start MDI to SDI transition
 - > Tray shows MDI child windows (need help from Chicago)
 - > Apps appear as document templates on desktop
 - > Factor a few more things into MOM 2, e.g. user assistance

Office '95 Features, Cont'd.

- ◆ **Exploit EMS/Notes/Ren**
 - > Save/Open documents to/from EMS & Notes, add support in Open/Save/Find File
 - > EMS Application F/X for Excel names, Word bookmarks
 - > Better Routing w/Mail form so user can fwd from Mail client
 - > Support To Do properties on documents for Ren views
 - > Support CMC/X from Excel VBA and Word Basic
- ◆ **Cross Application Features**
 - > Merge MOM and Ren launcher. Takes on container commands (window management, File New, Open) Supports "projects."
 - > New Find File 2.0 (content indexing); Word adopts it.
 - > Cheap, marketable, consistency/integration improvements, e.g. Symbol Manager as standard feature.
 - > AtWork support to FAX a document, dial a user
 - > MOS support (online registration, PSS, additional templates)
 - > Value Added: Bookshelf in CD Office, etc.

- ◆ Discoverability
 - > Shorter documentation (800pp for Office). Focus on top 10 tasks. Comprehensive docs only from Press. Overall reduction in words for print and on-line.
 - > IntelliSearch engine for Help with Natural Language Query
 - > Dialog tips for dialog controls instead of Help screens, dialog callouts
- ◆ Performance work by product groups
 - > Some 32 bit assembler for Chicago and NT versions
 - > OLE improvements in DocFiles and In situ, 32 bit only
- ◆ Annuity revenue
 - > Simplified network upgrade, e.g. incremental upgrade, installer creation Wizard
 - > Hermes, LSAPI, Product ID 2.0, System Profile Codes
- ◆ Address top 10 Office PSS issues
- ◆ Accessibility: Review Office 4.0 for problems

 - > SDI infrastructure
 - > Windows, events, menus, commands, dialogs

 - > "MOM 3" (now just extensions to the Memphis shell)
 - > User assistance
 - > Shared commands, e.g. File Open/Save, Search/Replace

Office '96 Key Features

- ◆ Designing support for user and business processes
 - > Office and Cairo conduct "In Context" user visits (Done)
 - > Model user and business processes (Done)
 - > Produce sequence diagrams, work flows
 - > Identify user "focus areas", e.g. collection, create/edit, deliver
 - > Merge Office & Cairo models into "Microsoft user activity model." Continue user visits and refine models.
 - > Office and Memphis co-design desktop
 - > Consistent non-overlapping design where apps leverage system.
 - > See next 3 slides for illustration of design stages
 - > Develop architecture to support user processes in apps and system
 - > Provide out-of-the box "Business Solution" wizards, e.g. an "AutoContent Wizard" for building processes.
 - > Provide necessary customization flexibility. Support adapting Office's standard process models to specific requirements.

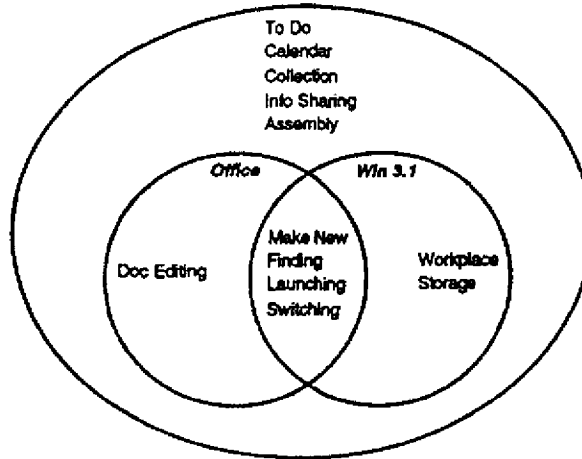

Support for User and Business Processes

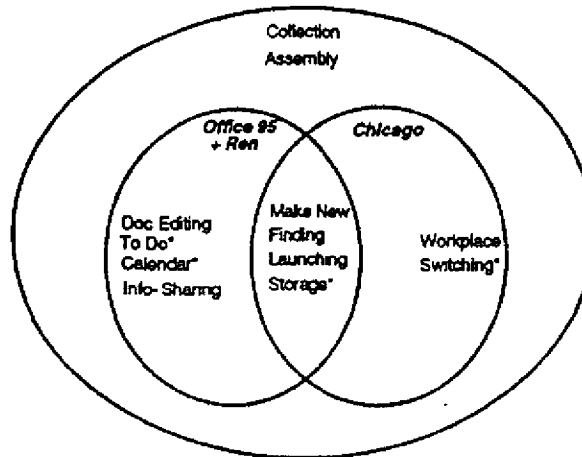

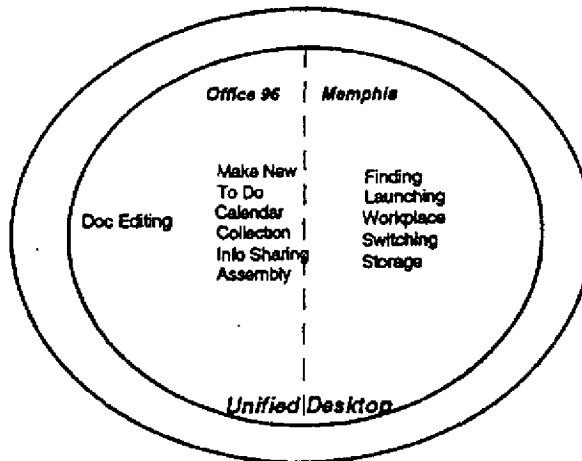

Office '96 Features, Cont'd.

◆ Your Assistant

- > Unified access to help
- > Social UI and the character
- > Unified IntelliSearch, Tip Wizard, IntelliSense engine
- > Cleaner, less redundant direct action UI, e.g. property sheets may replace both dialogs and toolbars

◆ Personal (adapts, learns)

- > Character is your friend; you choose your character
- > Office Connection facilitates group learning and expertise sharing
- > Auto-Personalize, e.g. auto-creation of templates and styles, MRU's for everything, Auto Auto learns your habits
- > Easier customizing, e.g. character helps with setup and options.
- > Per-user, portable, customization based on system log-in
- > A user who perceives Office as "trained" will not want to switch

Office '96 Features, Cont'd.

- ◆ Office + VBA is a "solution development platform"
 - > VBA 2.0 everywhere; component controls and forms
 - > Cross-app customization, error-checking, bullet-proofing
 - > Consistency of key classes
 - > Consistent add-in architecture
 - > One programming environment for all Office apps
 - > Personal assistants extensible with vertical solution knowledge
 - > Key goal: MIS, ISV's, and SP's will want to implement their business process solutions on top of Office.

Office '96 Features, Cont'd.

- ◆ Performance
 - > Target perceptible improvements
 - > 20% faster
 - > 20% less disk space
 - > 20% less resources
 - > Sometimes Shared Code will help...
 - > Toolbars (sharing will speed 2nd app start-up almost 20%)
 - > Also Willing to Re-Architect and Re-Code
 - > Target common operations: e.g. typing, scrolling, etc.
 - > and operations that are too slow today: e.g. "Make EXE" ability so add-ins don't take 8 sec to boot
 - > UI changes can often make operations "seem" faster
 - > e.g. Background printing actually slower, but returns control to user faster.
 - > More animation of state changes (e.g. window changes)
 - > More direct UI (i.e. MRU lists save user time)

◆ Microsoft Synergy

- > Very tight Windows integration
 - > Unified desktop based on co-designed common user model
 - > UI delegation to system, e.g. system will be *the* place to find and open files.
 - > Unified document architecture synergistic with the shell
 - > Full SDI
 - > Merge/reconciliation support
 - > Useful threads
 - > New visuals throughout (256 color palette)
- > Next level of EMS/OFS support
 - > e.g. auto versions; digital signatures; leverage address book
 - > MS On-Line, e.g. shared knowledge base, real-time reference
- > Sync with DDT direction on data access
- > Others, e.g. At Work, WinPad

◆ Annuity Business

- > Pull: Customers want to upgrade
 - > Assistance and business process themes target customer priorities.
- > Push: Create urgency
 - > Synch with Microsoft strategy and Memphis.
- > Facilitate: Break down the obstacles to upgrading
 - > CD ROM distribution MOS provide easier ways to buy
 - > Setup is easy and fun, e.g. character UI to setup/troubleshooting, knowledge base on CD, auto-config using user profiles and plug and play
 - > Painless corporate upgrades, e.g. overnight auto-install, mixed versions of Office coexist smoothly
 - > Slow the "acceleration" of upgrade hardware requirements
- > Entrench
 - > Lock-in because of customization, use in business processes, user attachment to personal character

Office '96 Omitted by Design

- ◆ **No single Office document type**
 - > Document architecture work will support this goal but will not be fully achieved infrastructure 1.0.
 - > May provide a binder-like container for managing looser collections of documents
- ◆ **Some VBA/infrastructure refinements will have to wait**
 - > Limited support for low-end programming, e.g. capsules, multiple-intent recording
 - > Limitations in cross-app VBA, e.g. cross-app bullet-proofing
 - > SDM will still be present. Not a good use of development resources in '96 to replace it

- ◆ Tier 1 within 60 days
- ◆ Tier 2 within 90 days

Business Implications

- ◆ Revenue issues
 - > Upgrade business increasingly important
 - > 12 % today, 26 % by 1997 (1 % installed base = \$31mm)
 - > Office SKU loses share but apps share rises slightly
 - > Office grows from 50 % to 70 % of DAD units
- ◆ Headcount
 - > Move approx. 1/3 dev & prog mgmt headcount from Word & Excel to Office BU. No net headcount change planned.
 - > All Word & Excel UE centralized in Office
 - > Parallel design of '95 and '96 hampered by shortage of program managers
- ◆ Product development costs
 - > More shared code
 - > Lower cost, long term
 - > Higher cost, short/medium term
 - > Outsource wherever possible, e.g. localization, RISC

- ◆ **Setup**
 - > Support 3 setups: Install off CD ROM to hard disk, admin setup and run products off CD
 - > Must use ACME for setup
- ◆ **Documentation**
 - > Convert diskette content and printed documentation to on-line
 - > Text and graphics configured for on-line and printed use
 - > Add multiple on-line doc access to product: User's Guide to Help menu, Program Item and toolbar button
- ◆ **Add Value to CD**
 - > Examples: templates, clip art, sample docs, icons, bigger spell checkers/thesauri
 - > Ship CD with your product unencrypted and complimentary products encrypted
