It is AMAZING to me what a good job your group has done mapping windows applications - I know we will keep finding boundary conditions and tuning for another year and thats important but I expected to find dozens and dozens more API mapping problems than you ended up with. In all the confusion about IBM and Os/2 I hope your group knows they are doing a great job -- just for Microsoft alone to be able to provide Os/2 applications with very little development work makes WLO a great asset - I even think IBM will come back to us some day and want to work with us on it.
