and CTRL+END do not work on the
keypad. When running Task Max,
CTRL+END doesn't go to the end
of a DOSBook topic (as DOSBook
Help says it should); rather, it
sends you out to Task Max.

| DR-DOS is not recognizing Home and End
| on the keypad (yes, I have Num Lock turned
| off). It DOES recognize Home and End
| on the set of keys above the arrow keys.

| Machine: Compaq 386
| Keyboard: Compaq

| This bug is important because in DOSBook,
| CTRL+HOME and CTRL+END are used to go
| to the top and bottom of a topic. If you
| are running DOSBOOK from the Shell and you
| have Task Switcher turned on, CTRL+END takes
| you to Task Switcher instead of to the bottom
| of the DOSBook topic. In a Hypertext system,
| losing your context unexpectedly like that
| is bad news.
