There has been lot of discussion on this point. I am not sure I would like to see some of it printed in the paper tomorrow, and since this info could be available to a court, I think we should be clear on what our intention is.

1. This is not a public policy, but an internal practice because we think it is in our best interest. We want to be AND appear fair with all windows developers. We want to encourage lots of software on windows.
2. Component of the system (Windows) will have many interfaces, some of which are not documented.

If any of our other products, which are not shipped in the same box with windows, uses any of the undocumented interfaces, we will document them. There are many ways to document them. The user of the undocumented interface is responsible to insure that DRG knows that the interface is being used and that there is a plan to document it.
