Folks were anxious to see what we might come up with for Office so here's a draft. I combined the two talks into a single file for simplicity, but followed the template pretty much exactly.

PLEASE PLEASE do not forward this around yet. This is mostly for structure. In particular, I think if things work out I will have time to change from our planning framework for the technical plan to the actual product focus areas-though that will be very close.

For the Office plan, the template makes it pretty clear which slides should come 100% from marketing for us:

- business goals (not sure where those metrics can come from)
- how we will succeed (business?)
- business development (this should be piracy, SKU issues, etc.)

Are there others from marketing that we would like to include? Seems a little short on marketing content to me-even relative to what Paul was asking for earlier. It is almost so short that it doesn't seem we will convey any new information at all (doesn't everyone know the numbers at this macro level?)

I think it would be good for us to have a single set of slides for "Input to the parts of Microsoft that control our business but don't work for us" (PSS, CU, and sales in particular). I took a stab at a couple of points.

I also made up a slide in the technical plan "Top Goals"--this one might be good for us to have a single one, or everyone can make up their own.

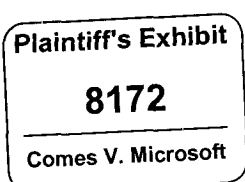

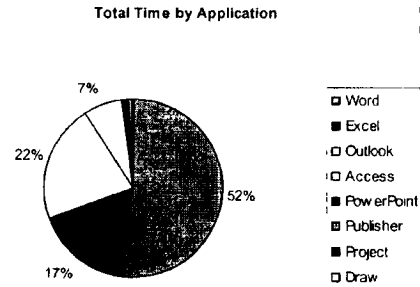
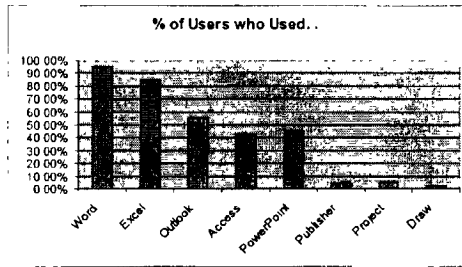

- Tells us: what are end-users really doing with the product

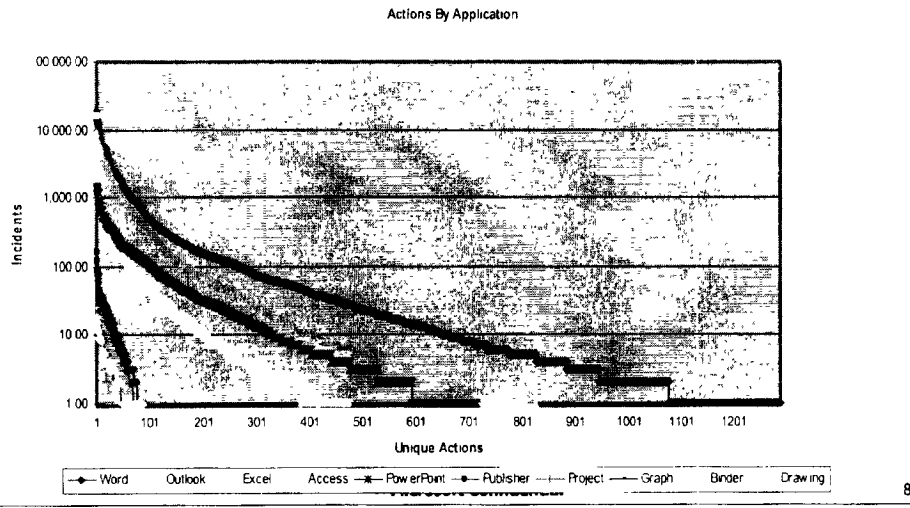
IV: Application Usage



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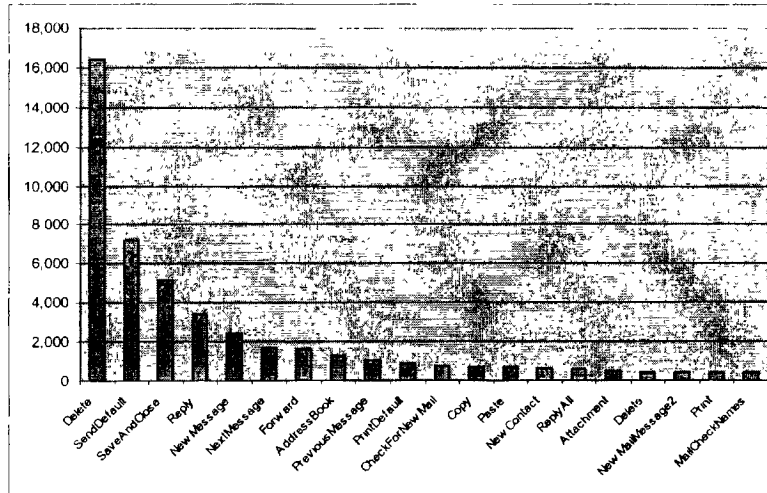
IV: Depth of Usage



IV: Files Opened and Saved

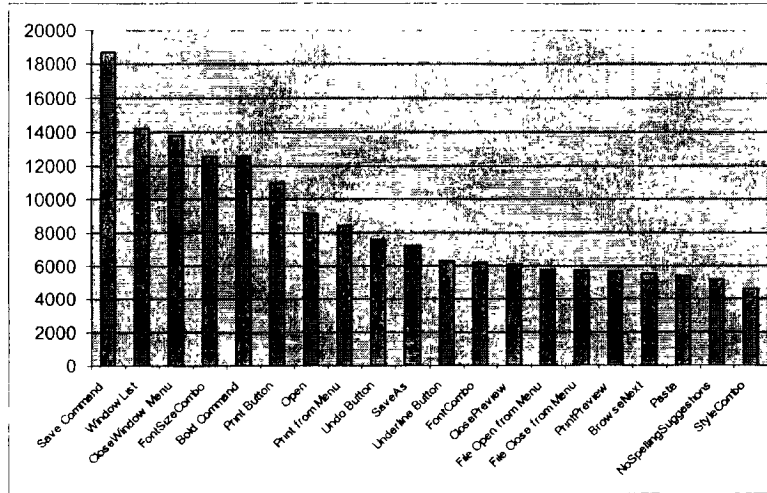

IV: Top Outlook Commands

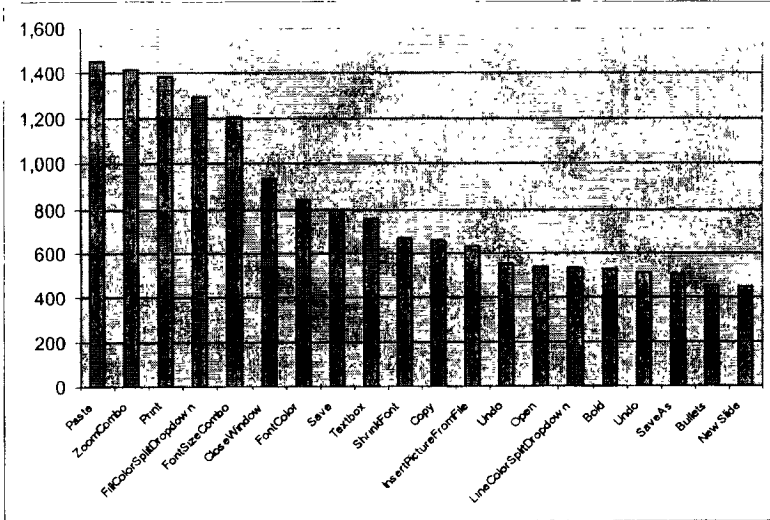


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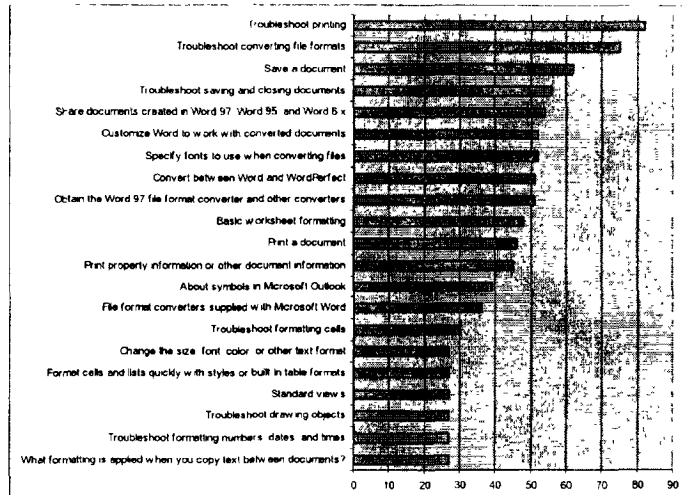
IV: Top Word Commands



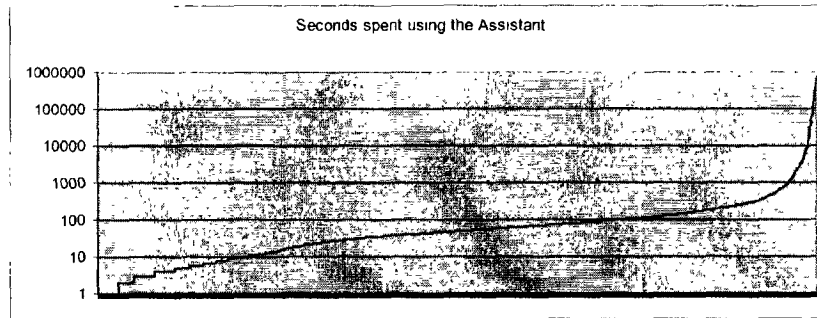
IV: Top PowerPoint Commands

- Many external issues: Windows 2000, Y2K, etc.

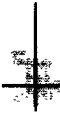
