The terms under which the Microsoft VM can be redistributed are covered in the SDK for Java and Microsoft VM EULAs. But yes, the Microsoft VM can be redistributed as long as the terms of the EULAs are met. I'm not going to make an open statement saying that all ISVs can redistribute with their apps but they can definitely review the terms of the license agreements listed below with their attorneys and make sure that they are in compliance.

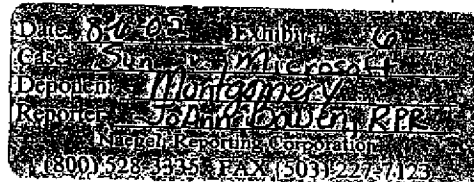

The VM will not ship on the Whistler media. If there is a pre-existing VM, it will be left on the machine.

The 32-bit version of IE has been modified to "install on demand" when it hits an applet and no "recent" VM exists on the machine. There is no equivalent functionality for applications.
