Brad, I spoke with anns, the woman in NT trying to put together the demo for paulma.

Under build 38 FS 4.0 runs OK in a windowed dos box. It is slow and has severe color mapping problems. I have submitted this bug. I also encountered another bug that is harder to reproduce which causes massive screen draw problems. This would not hurt a demo though.

The color mapping makes this undemoable in the current build -- it is that bad. If that problem is fixed it might actually be close to acceptable. With the tests that we have run on OS/2, DOS/OS2 cmd box scrolling is much smoother than in Windows so I would predict that FS is going to run much more smoothly on OS/2. Flight sim is a good slimely test app. We'll continue to use it...
