Subject: Bug Triaging - IE401/Memphis Bug Fix Criteria

We are trying to get a defined set of bugs require fixing for IE4.01 and Memphis.

We are currently marking these bugs in the database as **platform = memphis**.

Please look through the bugs you have reported that fall under the following criteria and/or you feel must be fixed for our next release (please put justification in the bug report). Please review ALL bugs - priority 1 & 2, and especially resolved postponed bugs.

The war team will begin formal bug reviews of these bugs on Monday.

Criteria for Must fix bugs for IE401/Memphis

- Client Issue - severe problem that causes customer visible issues
- PSS/Media hit - problem that will get media coverage and/or cause PSS support
- GPF within 1 hour
- Resource Leak - problem that would cause a restart
- Affects some key ISV or a lot of sites
- JCK 1.1 or 1.0.2 issue
- Risk - low risk - if bug fix affect or exposes other problems then postponed (if not an issue with the above).

Please note there are three known exceptions:

There are 3 known exceptions to this general set:

- * Security UI dialogs need to be redone (working with IE 4 folks)
- * Java printing of certain chars (mostly DBCS) is busted on Win95 - MSKK considers this crucial
 - Known bug in Win95 RichEdit that Office and others have worked around
 - Adding a more code than above criteria to just the printing path on Win95 for certain locales
 - However we will have this covered testing-wise
- * Win32 API classes for J/Direct will be rolled into IE 4.01
 - Testing will be covered and these classes are in the SDK
 - They did not make it into IE 4.0 for lack of test coverage
 - These are important strategically to get out through the OS
 - * Got approval from Memphis for this
